CALLING FOR VOLUNTEERS

Volunteers must be over 18 years of age, under 65 and with no underlying conditions.

Fraudulent priests

Some families invite so-called priests from other parts to come to Hemet to celebrate baptisms, masses, quinceañeras and first communions. Please note that a Catholic priest needs permission from the parish priest to celebrate any sacrament in his or her parish and that I have not given any priest permission to hold a baptism, wedding or quinceañera outside the temple.

As the alleged priests do not have my permission or of the Bishop, if they preside at a marriage outside the temple, such marriage is invalid. The faithful who participate in their supposed masses may be participating in a non-Catholic cult and it is quite possible that he who preaches is not ordained properly as the Church commands.

A sacrament received in the Old Catholic Church of Our Lady of Guadalupe is not recognized by the Roman Catholic Church and it is possible that there are no inscriptions of these simulated sacraments in any register of Sacraments. A certificate of Baptism or Marriage from this Church will not be accepted in any Roman Catholic Church.

Some of these fraudulent priests have been charged with criminal acts and it is possible that families are inviting criminals to their homes. In order to protect yourself better, and your children, please do not accept invitations to alleged masses celebrated outside the temple.

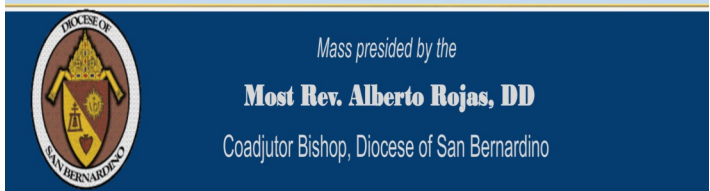


Bishop Barnes issues Formal Policy On Political Activity

With the presidential election 48 days away and political polarization at an all-time high, Bishop Barnes has issued a formal diocesan policy to guide clergy, religious and lay ministers in their public statements on political matters. The policy reaffirms the guidelines that are provided to church leaders each election year, adding any digital and social media statements that might be made. Church ministers are prohibited from making any public endorsements or condemnations of political candidates, according to the policy. Parishes and schools are not to allow political candidates access to their facilities for campaigning purposes, under the policy. Parishes are encouraged to hold candidate forums for local elections, and to provide non-partisan voter registration drives, under the policy.

Sacerdotes fraudulentos

Algunas familias invitan supuestos sacerdotes de otras partes para venir a Hemet a celebrar bautismos, misas, quinceañeras y primeras comuniones. Favor de tomar en cuenta que un sacerdote católico necesita el permiso del párroco para celebrar cualquier sacramento en su parroquia y que yo no he dado a ningún sacerdote permiso a celebrar un bautismo, boda o quinceañera fuera del templo.

Como los supuestos sacerdotes no tienen mi permiso ni del Sr. Obispo, si presiden un matrimonio fuera del templo, tal matrimonio es invalido. Los fieles que participen en sus supuestas misas pueden estar participando en un culto no católico y es muy posible que él que preside no es ordenado debidamente como la Iglesia manda.

Un sacramento recibido en la Iglesia Antigua-Católica de Nuestra Sra. de Guadalupe no está reconocido por la Iglesia Católica Romana y es posible que no haya inscripciones de esos sacramentos simulados en ningún archivo.

Además, algunos de esos sacerdotes fraudulentos han sido acusados de actos criminales y es posible que las familias estén invitando a criminales a sus casas. Para mejor protegerse, y a sus hijos, favor de no aceptar invitaciones a supuestas misas celebradas fueran del templo.



El Obispo Barnes Emite una Política Formal Sobre la Actividad Política

Con las elecciones presidenciales a solo 48 días y la polarización política que se encuentra en un máximo histórico, el Obispo Barnes emitió una política diocesana formal para guiar al clero, religiosos y ministros laicos en sus declaraciones públicas sobre asuntos políticos. La política reafirma los lineamientos que se les proveen a los líderes de la iglesia cada año electoral, añadiendo la mención de cualquier declaración digital o en las redes sociales que se pueda hacer. Se les prohíbe a los ministros de la Iglesia endosar o condenar públicamente a candidatos políticos, de acuerdo con la política. También bajo la política, se les prohíbe a las parroquias y escuelas permitir que los candidatos políticos tengan acceso a sus instalaciones para fines de su campaña. Se les anima a las parroquias organizar foros para candidatos de elecciones locales, y organizar campañas no-partidistas para registrar votantes.
