
Wills and Bequests

Coadjutor Bishop Alberto Rojas

Most Reverend Alberto Rojas was born January 5, 1965 in Aguascalientes, Mexico, a small state in the central part of the country. His parents are Fidel Rojas (deceased) and Maria De la Cruz Garcia. He has three sisters and four brothers.

Bishop Rojas was raised in a devoutly Catholic household and attended Catholic elementary school and high school in his community. He heard the call to the priesthood in his early teens and entered the Diocesan Seminary of Santa Maria de Guadalupe in Aguascalientes at the age of 15. During his seminary formation in Aguascalientes he also attended Colegio de Ciencias y Humanidades.

Following a visit with family members in California, Bishop Rojas made the decision to complete his seminary formation in the United States. He entered the University of St. Mary of the Lake Seminary in Mundelein, Illinois where he would complete his theological studies and earn a master's degree in Divinity. He was ordained a priest of the Archdiocese of Chicago by Francis Cardinal George on May 24, 1997 at Holy Name Cathedral in Chicago.

In the first years of his priestly ministry, Bishop Rojas served as Associate Pastor of St. Gregory the Great parish and then St. Rita parish in Chicago. "I was involved in many pastoral programs and doing ministry with people of all ages from many cultures was a great learning and joyful experience," he recalls of his years as a parish priest. In 2002, Cardinal George asked him to join the faculty of the University of St. Mary of the Lake Seminary where he taught for the next eight years.

He was ordained a bishop on August 10, 2011 at Holy Name Cathedral and is the only man that Cardinal George ordained both a priest and a bishop. He chose as his Episcopal Motto, *Nos basta el amor de Dios* (God's love is all we need).

In his service to the Archdiocese of Chicago as Auxiliary Bishop, Bishop Rojas served as the Episcopal Vicar of Vicariate III and later Vicariate I. He worked extensively in Hispanic ministry, serving as Cardinal George's Liaison to Hispanic Catholics and the Archbishop's Delegate to Consejo Pastoral Arquidiocesano Hispano-American. At the national level he has served as a Spiritual Assessor for the National Catholic Association of Diocesan Directors for Hispanic Ministry (NACDDHM).

Bishop Rojas has served on five committees of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops – Catholic Home Missions, Hispanic Affairs, Liturgy, the Church in Latin America and, most recently, V Encuentro as the Lead Bishop for Region VII.

On December 2, 2019, the Apostolic Nuncio to the United States announced that Pope Francis had appointed Bishop Rojas as the Coadjutor Bishop of San Bernardino.

Reflecting on his journey as a bishop at the time of his appointment as Coadjutor, Bishop Rojas stated, "Becoming a bishop has been a powerful, humbling, and learning experience because I never thought I would be one. However, in serving the people of God along with my brother priests, religious sisters, parish leaders, other auxiliary bishops, Cardinals, lay ecclesial movements and lay people in general, I have become more aware of who we are as Catholic Church. There is a beauty and a challenge in becoming part of the Church Jesus Christ founded once we understand the purpose of His mission which is the salvation of souls. But we also know Jesus is in charge, He is with us, and has given us the Holy Spirit to lead our steps along the way."

Coadjutor Obispo Alberto Rojas

El reverendo Alberto Rojas nació el 5 de enero de 1965 en Aguascalientes, México, un pequeño estado en la parte central del país. Sus padres son Fidel Rojas (fallecido) y María De la Cruz García. Tiene tres hermanas y cuatro hermanos.

El obispo Rojas se crio en un hogar católico devoto y asistió a la escuela primaria y secundaria católica en su comunidad. Escuchó el llamado al sacerdocio en su adolescencia temprana y entró al Seminario Diocesano de Santa María de Guadalupe en Aguascalientes a la edad de 15 años. Durante su formación en el seminario en Aguascalientes también asistió al Colegio de Ciencias y Humanidades.

Después de una visita con miembros de la familia en California, el obispo Rojas tomó la decisión de completar su formación en el seminario en los Estados Unidos. Ingresó al Seminario de la Universidad de St. Mary of the Lake en Mundelein, Illinois, donde completaría sus estudios teológicos y obtendría una maestría en Divinidad. Fue ordenado sacerdote de la Arquidiócesis de Chicago por el cardenal Francis George el 24 de mayo de 1997 en la Catedral de Santo Nombre en Chicago.

En los primeros años de su ministerio sacerdotal, el obispo Rojas sirvió como párroco asociado de la parroquia de San Gregorio Magno y luego de la parroquia de San Rita en Chicago. "Estuve involucrado en muchos programas pastorales y hacer ministerio con personas de todas las edades de muchas culturas fue un gran aprendizaje y una experiencia alegre", recuerda de sus años como párroco. En 2002, el cardenal George le pidió que se uniera a la facultad del seminario de la Universidad de St. Mary of the Lake, donde enseñó durante los siguientes ocho años.

Fue ordenado obispo el 10 de agosto de 2011 en la Catedral del Santo Nombre y es el único hombre que el cardenal George ordenó tanto sacerdote como obispo. Él eligió como su lema episcopal, "Nos basta el amor de Dios".

En su servicio a la Arquidiócesis de Chicago como Obispo Auxiliar, el Obispo Rojas sirvió como Vicario Episcopal del Vicariato III y luego Vicariato I. Trabajó extensamente en el ministerio hispano, sirviendo como Enlace del Cardenal George para los Católicos Hispanos y el Delegado del Arzobispo al Consejo Pastoral Arquidiocesano Hispano-Americanos. A nivel nacional, se ha desempeñado como Asesor Espiritual de la Asociación Católica Nacional de Directores Diocesanos para el Ministerio Hispano (NACDDHM).

El Obispo Rojas ha servido en cinco comités de la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos: Misiones Católicas Domésticas, Asuntos Hispanos, Liturgia, la Iglesia en América Latina y, más recientemente, V Encuentro como Obispo Principal para la Región VII.

El 2 de diciembre de 2019, el nuncio apostólico en los Estados Unidos anunció que el papa Francisco había nombrado al obispo Rojas como obispo coadjutor de San Bernardino.

Reflexionando sobre su viaje como obispo en el momento de su nombramiento como coadjutor, el obispo Rojas declaró: "Convertirse en obispo ha sido una experiencia poderosa, humilde y de aprendizaje porque nunca pensé que sería uno. Sin embargo, al servir al pueblo de Dios junto con mis hermanos sacerdotes, hermanas religiosas, líderes parroquiales, otros obispos auxiliares, cardenales, movimientos eclesiales laicos y laicos en general, me he dado cuenta de quiénes somos como Iglesia Católica. Hay una belleza y un desafío en formar parte de la Iglesia que Jesucristo fundó una vez que entendemos el propósito de Su misión, que es la salvación de las almas. Pero también sabemos que Jesús está a cargo, Él está con nosotros y nos ha dado el Espíritu Santo para guiar nuestros pasos en el camino.
